

The First Tee of Los Angeles collaborates with well-established, youth-serving agencies because they offer existing infrastructure of youth leaders and facilities to effectively deliver our nationally recognized curricula to more and more youth each year.

2019 YOUTH OUTCOMES

- 100% received full or partial scholarships
- 80% reported increased self-confidence
- 75% reported stronger leadership and decision-making skills
- 95% reported they will lead or continue to lead healthy lifestyles
- 73% reported that golf helped them increase their focus
- 75% reported that our program taught them better greeting skills
- 58% reported showing greater respect for themselves and others
- 54% reported that they had a better appreciation for diversity
- 94% shared ways in which they show respect off the golf course


